

AMENDED DOG ORDINANCE

(ORDINANCE #1001-A)
TOWN OF HILES

Forest County, Wisconsin

The town board of the Town of Hiles county of Forest, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. Dogs not to run at large. It shall be unlawfull for any person owning, keeping or harboring any dog, to permit such dog to run at large within the limits of the Town of Hiles, Forest County Wisconsin, at any time.

Sec. 2. The enforcement of this ordinance shall be carried out by the Town Chairman or Designee. If the identity and ownership of the dog offending private property can be readily ascertained, the enforcement officer may forth with advise such owner of the dogs transgressions. The owner having been so advised and continues to allow the dog(s) to run at large will be prosecuted as herein provided.

Sec. 3. License. A dog license is necessary for the keeping or harboring of any dog over the age of five (5) months as required by WI. Stats. 174.07.

Sec. 4. Vaccination. Any person who owns, harbors, keeps or controls a dog(s) in the Town of Hiles shall have said dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian within thirty(30) days after the dog reaches four (4) months of age as required by WI. Stats. 95.21.

Sec. 5. Penalties. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 dollars, nor more than \$50.00 dollars together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of fine imposed, with costs to be committed to the County Jail of Forest County for a term not to exceed ten (10) days.

Sec. 6. All ordinances, in whole or in part which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. 7. Intent. It is the intention of this ordinance to protect the citizens from the ravages and damages caused by dogs, particularly those owned by people who fail to respect the right of others. It is not the intention of this ordinance to penalize farmers or others, whose dog for the first time and without their knowledge cause disturbance.

Sec. 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication.
