

**July 11, 2018**

The regular monthly meeting of the Hiles Town Board was called to order at 7:00pm. Present: Lovrine, Bukovic, Tauer, clerk/treasurer Votis, and Deputy clerk/treasurer Micolichcek. Agenda was read and moved to approve Lovrine. Second Bukovic. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Minutes from June read. Motion to accept minutes as read Bukovic. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Treasurer report given. No questions. Sconic Net Contract Proposal: Tom Carlstedt presented contract proposal from Sconic Net to town board. Board discussed and Bukovic suggested to set fee at \$500, board will give contract to Steve Garbowicz the towns attorney for his opinion. On a side note Tom Carlstedt did say the Station B tower that was hit by GAD driver will be put up soon, parts have been ordered. Clerk Votis showed that check was deposited from Potawatomi TRIPP grant. Also presented board with rebate for \$100.00 from Menards. Tauer told he received a letter indicating that the town fuel tank was inspected and has several violations that need to be taken care of by next Monday. These include replacing the placards and painting. Tauer also spoke about the need to replace the one-ton pick-up has engine issues, repairs were quoted at \$10,000. Board discussed what to do and decided to get more quotes for pricing at other places. Bukovic gave update on progress on town hall upgrades and new pavilion by trap range. Stated privy by playground will have to wait for now. Lovrine asked if prices for cameras were received. CITIZEN INPUT: Tom Carlstedt asked if station B could build at lean-to on the back of station, Board said no, will need to be separate from building. Mark Ferris invited everyone to court house for WI Department of Tourism when they are to present check for JEM Grant. READING AND APPROVAL TO PAY VOUCHERS: Motion by Lovrine to approve for payment vouchers 19258 – 19288. Second Bukovic. Vote all aye. Motion Carried. Motion to adjourn Bukovic. Second Lovrine.
